WELCOME TO OUR RANCHERS BULL SALE...

Thank you for your interest in our program and our annual production sale. The cattle selling in this sale represent 35 years of selection for the kind of cattle that perform well on feed and hang a high quality carcass. There is real satisfaction in seeing these cattle go out to some of the premier commercial operations in our great beef state of Nebraska. These producers understand what it takes to make cattle profitable from the females to the feedlot.

In our operation, success as a seed stock breeder is measured by the ability of our genetics to perform in this commercial environment. Our breeding program has been directed by this philosophy from the beginning when we converted our ranch from a commercial herd in the mid-1970's. The lessons my dad learned from feeding both raised and purchased commercial cattle have held true through the last 36 years of raising registered cattle. The kind of cattle that worked the best for him and were the most profitable were the ones with the ability to gain fast and continue to gain efficiently to optimize carcass weight without producing an excessive number of yield grade 4's and 5's. This allows putting more pounds quickly on each animal placed on feed.

These cattle have been bred to perform in that way, along with the essential traits of production including disposition, fertility, calving ease, udders and soundness. The average \$Value for feedlot for all non-parent bulls in the Spring 2012 Sire Summary is \$26.79. The average for the bulls in this sale is \$51.52. This would rank our average sale bull in the top 2% of the breed.

We would again like to extend our appreciation to the people who make it possible to raise and grow these cattle and present them to you sale day. Our thanks to Sam Brown, Todd Stoltenberg and Lee Vincent and their families for their efforts and their dedication. We also want to thank our families, friends and neighbors who help us out during the year and at sale time.

We have tried to put as much information as possible in the sale catalog and will provide updated information sale day on actual weights, scrotal and pelvic measurements. There is some information on the bottom of this page that shows how our bulls scanned for ultrasound data compared to the breed average. The efficiency of the cattle selling, along with the cost of gain is noted on page 25. Please take the time to look at that information on those two pages. The volume discount, 100% first breeding season guarantee, delivery and boarding programs are also explained throughout the catalog. As we have the last several years, we will board all of the bulls after the sale for free. They will be turned out in a large pasture whenever the weather allows and will be bedded when needed. We will deliver the bulls for free in the state of Nebraska towards the end of March. We will also freeze brand the bulls with their tattoo if the buyers wish. So leave your trailers at home and drive whatever is the most comfortable sale day. We want the opportunity to exercise the bulls and have them ready for your environment. We also enjoy the opportunity to visit your ranch when we deliver them. If you can't make it sale day, we will help arrange someone to bid on the cattle for you. Complete satisfaction guaranteed.

 (aka HD)

The top selling bull in last year's sale with 1/2 interest going to Mart McNutt for \$11,500. Sired by HA Image Maker and weighing only 68 pounds at birth, "HD" went on to post a 1503 pound adj. 365 day weight along with a 16.6 inch Ribeye. "HD" has extra length of body, good depth and is clean sheathed. The first calves are on the ground and are coming easy, with an average birth weight of 71 pounds on 24 calves out of first calf heifers. The dam of "HD" is a daughter of Sitz New Design 458N that posts a 88 birth weight ratio on her first two calves. We will get a large group of calves by "HD" this spring and think he shows a lot of potential as a herd sire.
